

Data Protection Policy

BACS is a membership-based association and UK registered charity #272144, which is run by volunteers. As defined by the new *General Data Protection Regulation* we neither ask for, nor would we retain, *sensitive* personal information. The most *basic* of personal information: name, postal address, and e-mail address, is needed in order for BACS to alert its members to its activities, future conferences, Journal, prizes, publications by members, Canadian Studies events worldwide, funding opportunities and other important notices. Even such basic data is not, nor ever would be, shared with third parties other than:

- a) Our journal publishers in order that they may supply you, if you are a subscriber, with the *British Journal of Canadian Studies*.
- b) Conference venues/organisers so that only officially registered delegates are admitted.

Its members or those intending to become members initiate contact with BACS. Hence, if you consent to be on the BACS mailing list you agree to the collection, use, and sharing of your personal data as outlined above, this will be taken to mean that you have actively consented to have your name and contact details securely stored by BACS. However, if BACS members decide that they wish to withdraw their consent for their information to be stored and used as outlined above, they can inform the BACS Secretary of this, and their contact details will be removed from the secure database.
